



## SHOT MINING A BIG SUCCESS

ummer is in the history books now, but as they say, it's gone but not forgotten.

Most notable was the great success we had with our lead shot recovery. The miners recovered and reclaimed over 36 tons of lead. Of

that, over 4,000 lb was cleaned and regraphited, then sold back to our shooters for about half the cost of new lead shot. That's an economic and environmental record to be proud of.

We need to thank club member **Steve Underwood** and his daughter **Brittany** for their hard work in cleaning and bagging. It's not an easy job, and they did it superbly.

What's that mean for WWGC? It means we now have the funds to finish the pistol range project. Prior to mining, we had run out of building funds. With the success of mining and the Hi-Yu shoot just concluded, we now have \$35,000.00 in the construction account that we can use. That's more than enough to finish the pistol range to a most usable degree.

At this writing, **Kris Carver's** crew were busily sealing up the gaps in the enviro-blocks. As that is being done, club member **Billy Stahlheber's** crew from **Doyle Electric** will start on the rest of the wiring necessary to tie the range to the clubhouse.

Once that's done, Doyle will hang the rest of the target track, install some lights in the range tunnels, and make provision for future electrical additions as they become reality.

The one thing we've not much discussed at our board meetings is, what kind of shooting benches we want to install? Can we build our own, or is it more cost effective to buy them off the shelf? These are questions we will wrestle with at our October 12 board meeting.

If you have any ideas or suggestions to this end, please pass them along to a board member, or better yet, come in person to the board meeting (5:00 pm on Oct. 12) and share them with us.

As you may have noticed, the **Friends of NRA** have been moribund ever since the pandemic. There have been no banquets, fund raisers, or money dispersal to clubs for their projects. In fact, we've had our funding requests rejected for lack of available capital. They have told us, "no banquet, no funding." I guess that says it all.

But there is reason to hope. Recently I've been in touch with FNRA's new area representative, **Robert Berg**. Robert is from central Oregon, not Seattle or Portland, so he is more attuned

PISTOL RANGE NEAR!
BACKSTOP GOING IN
LIGHTING AND TARGET RETRIEVAL NEXT
HI-YU SHOOT A GREAT SUCCESS

At this writing, **Kris Carver's** crew were busily sealing up the gaps in the enviro-blocks that make up the walls of our new pistol range tunnels.

You may not know this, but Doyle Electric is only charging us their cost for time and materials, without taking one thin dime in profit. Their generosity is saving us in the neighborhood of \$15-\$20,000.00, and is making it possible to complete our project with the money we have on hand.




